Who is eligible to enter this contest?

How will participants be recognized and awarded?

Essay entries must be received by the Rotary Club of Woodridge no later than March 31, 2010.

Rotary District 6450 winning entry will be submitted by the Rotary Club of Woodridge to the District no later than April 14, 2010.

What is the Rotary Club of Woodridge's Award for the winning essay?

- \$50 EE U.S. Savings Bond in name of the Student
- \$50 Cash to the Respective School in the Student's name

What are the Rotary District 6450 Awards for the overall winning essays?

- 1st Place.....\$150.00
- 2nd Place.....\$100.00
- 3rd Place\$50.00

- Compose a 250-300 word essay using the following subject topic:
"How I can apply the Four-Way Test in my life"
- Type your essay (or Microsoft Word document or comparable format)
